Bubolz Nature Preserve

Food Menu Presentation at Primrose Retirement Community

Network Health partnered with Primrose Retirement Community in April to offer more healthy food options on their restaurant menu. Our wellness coordinators also reviewed the menu with residents to identify food choices to support lowering blood pressure, cholesterol and high blood sugar.

Member Welcome Events

We offer in-person and virtual events for members to learn about available resources including our pharmacists, wellness coordinators and member experience team. In the last three months 78 members attended in-person events while 83 members took advantage of a virtual option.

Oshkosh Senior Center (OSC) National Senior Health and Wellness Day

On May 29 the Network Health team attended National Senior Health and Wellness Day at the OSC to help participants identify healthy beverage choices low in sugar and calories. We met with over 140 people from the community, including 26 members.

Medicare Diabetes Prevention Program (MDPP)

Network Health continues to offer MDPP which teaches methods to prevent or delay type 2 diabetes for our members and others in the community. The goal of the program is to decrease blood sugar through increased physical activity, healthy eating and weight loss. Thirty-four participants have lost over 300 pounds in their journey to better health.

Capri Communities Enjoy Life Active Aging Symposium

Network Health was a lead sponsor at the 2nd Annual Capri Communities Enjoy Life Active Aging Symposium on June 11. Our President and CEO, Coreen Dicus-Johnson, introduced John McGivern as the keynote speaker to a sold-out crowd, while our team hosted three healthy cooking demonstrations. At the event, we met more than 30 Network Health members, greeted over 1,000 attendees, handed out 52 referral cards and generated leads for our sales team.

Gee's MKE Wellness Clinic - Juneteenth Parade

On June 19, Network Health and Gee's MKE Wellness Clinic walked in the Juneteenth Bronzeville Neighborhood Parade. This is one of the largest and longest running Juneteenth celebrations in the country with over 45,000 people lining the parade route. We met 850 people at the Network Health/Gee's MKE Wellness Clinic booth.

Milwaukee County Zoo - Senior Safari

Again this year, Network Health was the entertainment sponsor at the Senior Safari events at the Milwaukee County Zoo, featuring musical guests including Marcell Guyton and Piano Man Extraordinaire. One thousand attendees ages 60+ were able to attend the event with free admission to enjoy a day of fun.

Versiti Blood Drive

Network Health collaborated with High Point Dentistry, JAX, and Versiti, on a blood drive at JAX in Menomonee Falls. This event attracted 32 donors and potentially saved nearly 100 lives through those donations. Our President and CEO, Coreen Dicus-Johnson, participated as a first-time donor.
